Proposals will be publicly opened during the regularly scheduled Harris County ESD #46 board meeting at 4:00 pm (CDT) on Monday, September 21, 2015. WRITTEN CONTRACT

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GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. **BID NOTIFICATION:** Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department utilizes the following procedures for notification of bid opportunities: direct e-mail solicitation, advertisement(s) in the Houston Chronicle, and/or the Department's website: www.AVFD.com. It shall be the bidder's responsibility to verify the validity of all bid information received by sources other than those listed.
- 2. REQUIRED INFORMATION: Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department bid/proposal packets contain various sections requiring completion. The bid form section of the bid packet must be completed prior to the date and time set for bid opening and included with the bid packet or the bidder may be found non-responsive. Vendors may be required to complete and supply all information contained in the "supplemental information" portion of the packet at a date after bid opening. Failure to complete "supplemental information" requirements in a timely manner, may be used by the Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department in determining a vendor's responsibility.
- 3. MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR RESPONSIBLE PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS: a prospective bidder must affirmatively demonstrate their responsibility. The Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department may request representation and other information sufficient to determine bidder's ability to meet these minimum standards including but not limited to:
 - A. Have adequate financial resources, or the ability to obtain such resources as required;
 - B. Be able to comply with the required or proposed delivery schedule;
 - C. Have satisfactory record of performance with this project or similar type work;
 - D. Have a satisfactory record of integrity and ethics;
 - E. Otherwise qualified and eligible to receive an award.
- 4. <u>CORRESPONDENCE:</u> the number of this bid packet must appear on all correspondence, or inquiries, pertaining to this quotation.
- 5. <u>PREPARATION COST:</u> the Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department will not be liable for any costs associated with the preparation, transmittal, or presentation of any bids or materials submitted in response to any bid, quotation, or proposal.
- 6. NOTICE OF PUBLIC DOCUMENTS: any and all materials initially or subsequently submitted as part of the bid process shall become the property of the Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department, and shall be treated as Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department documents subject to typical practice and applicable laws for public records.
- 7. ADDENDA: any interpretations, corrections or changes to this bid packet will be made by addenda. Sole issuing authority shall be vested in the Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department. Addenda will be sent to all who are known to have received a copy of this bid packet, if the addenda contain changes to the "specification" or "bid form", bidders shall acknowledge receipt of all addenda or they may be declared non-responsive.
- 8. **REVISED BIDS:** the bid that is submitted last will supersede any previous versions.
- 9. <u>INSURANCE:</u> the Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department requires vendor(s) to carry the minimum insurance as required by state laws, and insurance requirements outlined in the bid/proposal documents.

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- 10. SILENCE OF SPECIFICATION: the apparent silence of these specifications as to any detail or to the apparent omission from it of a detailed description concerning any point, shall be regarded as meaning that only the best commercial practices are to prevail. All interpretations of these specifications shall be made on the basis of this statement.
- 11. TAXES: the Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department is exempt from federal manufacturer's excise and state sales and use tax. Tax must not be included in bid. Tax exemption certificates will be executed by the Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department and furnished upon request.
- 12. **PRICING:** bid price(s) quoted, must be held firm for ninety (90) days to allow for evaluation unless otherwise stated in this document.
- 13. **ERROR-QUANTITY:** bid price must be submitted on units of quantity specified, extended, and total shown, in the event of discrepancies in extensions, the unit price shall govern.
- 14. WARRANTY/GUARANTEE LAWS AND REGULATIONS: By submittal of this bid, in addition to the guarantees and warranties provided by law, vendor expressly guarantees and warrants as follows:
 - A. That the articles to be delivered hereunder will be in full conformity with the specifications or with the approved sample submitted, and agreed that this warranty shall survive acceptance of delivery and payment for the articles and that the vendor will bear the cost of inspecting and/or testing articles rejected.
 - B. That the articles to be delivered hereunder will not infringe on any valid patent, trademark, trade name, or copyright, and that the vendor will, at vendor's own expense, defend any and all actions or suits charging such infringement and will save and hold harmless the Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department, its officers, employees, agents, and representatives from any and all claims, losses, liabilities and suits arising there from.
 - C. That the articles to be delivered hereunder will be manufactured, sold and/or installed in compliance with the provisions of all applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations.
 - D. That nothing contained herein shall exclude or affect the operation of any implied warranties otherwise arising in favor of the Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department.
- 15. **PACKAGING:** unless otherwise indicated, items will be new, unused, and in first rate condition in containers suitable for damage-free shipment and storage.
- 16. F.O.B./DAMAGE: quotations shall be bid F.O.B. delivered, designated location, and shall include all delivery and packaging costs. The Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department assumes no liability for goods delivered in damaged or unacceptable condition. The successful bidder shall handle all claims with carriers, and in case of damaged goods, shall ship replacement goods immediately up on notification by the Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department of damage.
- 17. <u>DELIVERY PROMISE PENALTIES:</u> quotations must show the number of calendar days required to place the materials in the possession of the Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department. Do not quote shipping dates. When delivery delay can be foreseen, the

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bidder shall give prior notice to the purchasing division, who shall have the right to extend the delivery date if reasons for delay appear acceptable. Default in promised delivery, without acceptable reasons, or failure to meet specifications, authorizes the purchasing division to purchase goods elsewhere, and charge any increase in cost and handling to the defaulting bidder.

- 18. **PAYMENT TERMS:** payment terms are net 30 unless otherwise specified by the Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department in the bid/proposal packet.

- 23. BID OPENINGS: all bids submitted will be read at the Proposals will be publicly opened during the regularly scheduled Harris County ESD #46 board meeting indicated on the RFP. Board meetings are held at 7pm (CDT) at 18425 Timber Forest Drive, Humble, TX 77346. Only the names of the firms submitting proposals will be read aloud at the public opening. However, the reading of a bid at bid opening should not be construed as a comment on the responsiveness of such bid or as any indication that the Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department accepts such bid as responsive. The Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department will make a determination as to the responsiveness of bids submitted based upon compliance with all applicable laws, Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department purchasing guidelines, and project documents, including but not limited to the bid/proposal specifications and required submittal documents. The Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department will notify the successful bidder upon award of the contract and, according to state law all bids received will be available for inspection at that time.
- 24. MINOR DEFECT: the Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department reserves the right to waive any minor defect, irregularity, or informality in any bid. The Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department may also reject any or all bids without cause prior to award.
- 25. **EVALUATION:** bids/proposals will be evaluated as outlined in the bid/proposal document.
- 26. SPLIT AWARD: the Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department reserves the right to award a separate contract to separate vendors for each item/group or to award one contract for the entire bid. The Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department reserves the right to take into consideration contract administration costs for multiple award contracts when determining low bid.
- 27. **PROTESTS:** all protests regarding the bid solicitation process must be submitted in writing to the e-mail or physical address listed on the bid packet within ten (10) working days following the opening of bids, unless otherwise required by Texas

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law. This includes all protests relating to advertising of bid notices, deadlines, bid opening, and all other related procedures under the local government code, as well as any protests relating to alleged improprieties or ambiguities in the specifications. The limitation does not include protests relating to staff recommendations as to award of this bid. - 28. - 29. <u>CONFLICTS:</u> In the event the terms and conditions herein expressed conflict with the terms and conditions of any specifications issued by the Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department in conjunction with this purchase, the specifications shall supersede these terms and conditions to the extent of the conflict.
- 30. <u>AUTHORIZATION:</u> The Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department will not accept or pay for articles delivered or services performed without a specific written Purchase Order.
- 31. CONFORMITY OF GOODS/SERVICES: All goods to be delivered or services to be performed shall conform in every respect to the specifications issued by the Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department in conjunction with its solicitation of bids or proposals. In the event no such specifications were issued, the goods or services shall conform to the proposal submitted by the vendor.
- 32. WARRANTY/GUARANTEE LAWS AND REGULATIONS: By acceptance of this order, in addition to the guarantees and warranties provided by law, contractor expressly guarantees and warrants as follows:
 - A. That the articles to be delivered hereunder will be in full conformity with the specifications or with the approved sample submitted, and agreed that this warranty shall survive acceptance of delivery and payment for the articles and that the contractor will bear the cost of inspecting and/or testing articles rejected.
 - B. that the articles to be delivered hereunder will not infringe on any valid patent, trademark, trade name, or copyright, and that the contractor will, at contractor's own expense, defend any and all actions or suits charging such infringement and will save and hold harmless the Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department, its officers, employees, agents, and representatives from any and all claims, losses, liabilities and suits arising there from.
 - C. that the articles to be delivered hereunder will be manufactured, sold and/or installed in compliance with the provisions of all applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations.
 - D. that nothing contained herein shall exclude or affect the operation of any implied warranties otherwise arising in favor of the Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department.

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- 33. **PRICING:** Unit pricing shall be in strict conformity with the bid or proposal submitted by vendor, unless a price increase is authorized by the Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department.
- 34. PRICE REDUCTION: if during the life of the contract, the contractor's net prices to other customers for the same product(s) and/or service(s) are lower than the Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department contracted prices, an equitable adjustment shall be made in the contract price.
- 35. **DELIVERY TIMES:** deliveries will be acceptable only during normal working hours at the designated location.
- 36. <u>DELIVERY PROMISE PENALTIES:</u> default in promised delivery without acceptable reasons, or failure to meet specifications, authorizes the department to purchase goods/services elsewhere, and charge any increase in cost and handling to the defaulting contractor.
- 37. INSPECTION, REJECTION, AND EXCESS SHIPMENT: In addition to other rights provided by law, the Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department reserves the right (a) to inspect articles delivered and to return those which do not meet specifications or reasonable standards of quality, (b) to reject articles shipped contrary to instructions or in containers which do not meet recognized standards, and (c) to cancel the order if not filled within the time specified. The Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department may return rejected articles or excess shipment on this order, or may hold the articles subject to the vendor's order and at vendor's risk and expense, and may in either event charge the vendor with the cost of shipping, unpacking, inspecting, repacking, reshipping and other like expenses.
- 38. **INVOICES:** invoices must be submitted by the contractor to the Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department, Accounts Payable, 18425 Timber Forest Drive, Humble, TX 77346. The Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department Purchase Order number must appear on all invoices, delivery memoranda, bills of lading, packing and correspondence.
- 39. **PATENT RIGHTS:** the contractor agrees to indemnify and hold the Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department harmless from any claim involving patent right infringement or copyrights on goods supplied.
- 40. **ASSIGNMENT:** the contractor shall not sell, assign, transfer or convey this contract in whole, or part, without the prior written consent of the purchasing division.
- 41. <u>AUDIT:</u> the Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department reserves the right to audit the records and performance of contractor during the contract and for three years thereafter.
- 42. CHANGE ORDERS: no oral statement of any person shall modify or otherwise change, or affect the terms, conditions or specifications stated in this contract. All change orders to the contract will be made in writing by the Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department.
- 43. INDEMNIFICATION: contractor agrees to defend, indemnify and hold the Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department (and Harris County Emergency Services District No. 46) and its respective officers, agents and employees, harmless against any and all claims, lawsuits, judgments, fines, penalties, costs and expenses for personal injury (including death), property damage, intellectual property infringement claims (including patent, copyright and trademark infringement) or other harm or violations for which recovery of damages, fines, or penalties is sought, suffered by any person or persons that may arise out of or be occasioned by contractor's

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breach of any of the terms or provisions of the contract, violations of law, or by any negligent, grossly negligent, intentional, or strictly liable act or omission of the contractor, its officers, agents, employees, invitees, subcontractors, or sub- subcontractors and their respective officers, agents, or representatives, or any other persons or entities for which the contractor is legally responsible in the performance of the contract. The indemnity provided for in this paragraph shall not apply to any liability resulting from the sole negligence of Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department (and Harris County Emergency Services District No. 46), and its officers, agents, employees or separate contractors. Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department (and Harris County Emergency Services District No. 46) does not waive any governmental immunity or other defenses available to it under Texas or federal law. The provisions of this paragraph are solely for the benefit of the parties hereto and are not intended to create or grant any rights, contractual or otherwise, to any other person or entity.

- Α. Contractor, at its own expense, is expressly required to defend Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department against all such claims. Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department reserves the right to provide a portion or all of its own defense; however, Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department is under no obligation to do so. Any such action by Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department is not to be construed as a waiver of contractor's obligation to defend Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department or as a waiver of contractor's obligation to indemnify Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department pursuant to this agreement. Contractor shall retain defense counsel within seven (7) business days of Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department's written notice that Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department is invoking its right to indemnification under this agreement. If contractor fails to retain counsel within the required time period, Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department shall have the right to retain defense counsel on its own behalf and contractor shall be liable for all costs incurred by Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department.
- B. In addition to contractor's intellectual property infringement indemnification and defense requirements herein, if an infringement claim occurs, or in contractor's opinion is likely to occur, contractor shall, at its expense: (a) procure for the department the right to continue using the product; (b) replace or modify the product so that it becomes non-infringing while Providing functionally equivalent performance; or (c) accept the return of the product and grant city a reimbursement for the product. Contractor will proceed under subsection (c) above only if subsections (a) and (b) prove to be commercially unreasonable.
- C. The intellectual property infringement indemnification herein applies to all products provided, supplied or sold under this agreement by contractor to Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department whether manufactured by contractor or a third party. Contractor represents that, to the best of its knowledge, Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department's use of products that are provided supplied, or sold by contractor to Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department as part of this agreement does not constitute an infringement of any intellectual property rights and Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department has the legal right to use said products. Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department enters into this agreement relying on this representation.
- D. The indemnification herein survives the termination of the contract and/or dissolution of this agreement including any infringement cure provided by the contractor.

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- 44. **TERMINATION**: the Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department may, at its option, with or without cause, and without penalty or prejudice to any other remedy it may be entitled to at law, or in equity or otherwise under this Contract, terminate further work under this contract, in whole or in part by giving at least thirty (30) days prior written notice thereof to Contractor with the understanding that all services being terminated shall cease upon the date such notice is received unless otherwise indicated in writing by the Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department.
- 45. TERMINATION FOR DEFAULT: the Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department reserves the right to enforce the performance of the contract in any manner prescribed by law or deemed to be in the best interest of the Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department in the event of breach or default of the contract. The Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department reserves the right to terminate the contract immediately in the event the contractor fails to 1) meet delivery schedules or, 2) otherwise perform in accordance with these specifications. Breach of contract or default authorizes the Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department to award contract to another contractor, purchase elsewhere and charge the full increase in cost and handling to the defaulting contractor.
- 46. **REMEDIES:** the contractor and the Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department agree that each party has rights, duties, and remedies available as stated in the uniform commercial code and any other available remedy, whether in law or equity.
- 47. <u>VENUE:</u> this agreement will be governed and constructed according to the laws of the state of Texas. This agreement is performable in Harris County, Texas. Exclusive venue shall be in Harris County, Texas.
- 48. **EMPLOYMENT ELIGIBILITY VERIFICATION:** the immigration reform and control act of 1986 (IRCA) makes it illegal for employers to knowingly hire or recruit immigrants who do not possess lawful work authorization and requires employers to verify their employees' work eligibility on a U.S. department of justice form I-9.
- 49. IRCA: The contractor warrants that contractor is in compliance with IRCA and will maintain compliance with IRCA during the term of the contract with the Atascocita Volunteer Fire Department. Contractor warrants that contractor has included or will include a similar provision in all written agreements with any subcontractors engaged to perform services under this contract.
