Notice is hereby given that **Harris County Emergency Services District No. 46** will hold a public meeting on **August 17, 2026 at 7:00 p.m.**, at the **Atascocita Fire Department, Headquarters Building** located at **18425 Timber Forest Drive, Humble, Texas 77346**.

The District will consider and act upon the following matters:

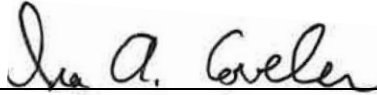
1. Call meeting to order, roll call, and establish a quorum.
2. Join together in the Pledge of Allegiance.
3. Recognition, Promotions, Commendations and Awards for District members.
4. To receive public comment and conduct the public hearing/open forum to allow interested parties to address the Board of Commissioners and be heard regarding the proposed property tax rate setting.
5. Conclude Public Hearing on Tax Increase.
6. To consider and adopt the District's 2027 Budget.
7. To adopt the District's 2026 Ad Valorem Tax Rate for Debt Service.
8. To adopt the District's 2026 Ad Valorem Tax Rate for Maintenance and Operations.
9. To adopt the District's 2026 total Ad Valorem Tax Rate.
10. To receive public comments related to regular agenda matters.
11. To review, discuss and take action on any matters related to the District's construction projects.
12. To review, discuss and take action on pay applications presented.
13. To receive a financial report and take any necessary action regarding the report.
14. To pay District bills and approve commissioner submittals pursuant to Texas Health and Safety Code §775.038(a-1).
15. To review, discuss and take action regarding District Government Affairs.
16. To receive a sales tax report from ESD Tax Management Services.
17. To approve the Minutes of prior meeting(s).
18. To review, discuss and take action on the Department reports.
19. To review, discuss and take action on submittals of thirty (30) day advance request(s) for necessary purchases related to the provision of emergency services in accordance with the current District Budget.
20. To review, discuss and take action for the sale or disposal of obsolete surplus and/or salvage property pursuant to Texas Health and Safety Code §775.0735.

21. To review, discuss and act regarding purchase requests and requisitions, and acquisitions, repairs or maintenance related to Department, facilities, apparatus, vehicles, technology, and equipment in service to the District.
22. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.071 to consult with legal counsel or to discuss sales tax matters as permitted by Tax Code §323.3022.
23. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.074 to discuss personnel matters.
24. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.072 to deliberate regarding real estate matters.
25. Review and take action on District real estate matters and personnel matters.
26. Discuss any new items which need to be on the agenda for the subsequent District meetings, including the regular District meeting set for September 21, 2026.
27. Receive any announcements from the Board of commissioners or the Department staff.

TAXPAYER IMPACT STATEMENT

House Bill 1522, passed by the Texas Legislature in 2025, amends section 551.043 of the Texas Government Code to require that the notice of a meeting required to be posted under section 551.043(c) of the Texas Open Meetings Act, at which a governmental body will discuss or adopt a budget for the governmental body, must include a taxpayer impact statement showing, for the median-valued homestead property, a comparison of the property tax bill in dollars pertaining to the property for the current fiscal year to an estimate of the property tax bill in dollars for the same property for the upcoming fiscal year.

Harris County Emergency Services District No. 46 (“District”) has proposed a budget for the District’s 2027 fiscal year to be funded in part by the 2026 Property Tax Rate to be adopted by the District. The District intends to adopt its budget on or before September 30, 2026.

Estimated Property Tax Bill for Current Fiscal Year:

- Value of Median-Valued Homestead Property in the District for 2025: \$284,634
- Property Tax Bill for the Current Fiscal Year at the adopted 2025 rate (\$0.100000): \$284.63

Comparison of Estimated Property Tax Bill for the Upcoming Fiscal Year if the District Adopts the Proposed Budget and Tax Rate (\$0.100000) versus the No New Revenue Rate (\$0.099696):

- Value of Median-Valued Homestead Property in the District for 2026: \$286,148
- Property Tax Bill for the Current Fiscal Year at the proposed 2026 rate (\$0.100000): \$286.15
- Estimated Property Tax Bill for the Upcoming Fiscal Year if the District Adopts a Balanced Budget Funded at the No-New-Revenue Tax Rate (\$0.099696): \$285.28

The estimates in this Impact Statement are valid only for the proposed budget and proposed tax rate that the District Board of Commissioners will discuss at its meeting on August 17, 2026. This Taxpayer Impact Statement is included in the public notice posted on the District website for the District meeting to be held on August 17, 2026.
